- For ages 2-13 per person: 1 day \$50, 2 - \$90, 3 - \$120, 4 - \$145, 5 - \$150 and 6 - \$150.

- Waterfront: Swim, Kayak, Canoe, Sailing, Rowing, Snorkeling, Paddle-Board.
- Nature: Astronomy, Nature Hike, Geology, Fauna, Leave No Trace, Ecology.
- Shooting Sports: 22s, Archery, Shotgun, Tomahawks, Black Powder, Sling Shots.
- Scoutcraft: Painting, Leatherwork, Wood Carving.
- Cope And Climbing: Zip Lines, High Cope, Obstacle Course, Climbing.
- Outdoor Skills: Rope Making, Pioneering, Gps, Orienteering, Fishing (\$5 for the license).

THE FINE PRINT

- A BSA physical is required to participate in waterfront, climbing or staying more than 72 hours.
- You will need to pass the BSA swim check at the waterfront for water activities.
- No dogs or other pets are allow at camp.
- Shooting Sports will have a standard fee for bullets and shotgun shells.
- Space is limited for Capote making, bring your own wool blanket.
- Give us your menu for the cook-off, plan to feed 20 people - a 14" Dutch Oven.
- Business exhibits in the Commercial building. Let us know if you want to participate (no fee).
- Let us know your lodging needs - campsite preference, RV dry camping, tents are available.
- A tentative daily schedule will be provided by March 31.
- Registration begins NOW.
- Free early arrival is allowed on Sunday after noon 7/28, but no services are provided.
- Bicycles in camp are allowed on roads but not allowed on trails for safety. Helmets are required.
- RV camping is allowed only in the south parking lot.
- Vehicles are restricted to camp roads and parking areas, not in campsites or program areas.
